CROS P will transfer sound and voices, enabling your better hearing ear to access sounds from both sides.

If you have normal hearing or aidable hearing loss in one ear and no usable hearing in the other ear, CROS P is designed for you. You'll be able to hear your partner or colleague in a noisy cafe even though they are talking on your poorer side.

CROS stands for 'Contralateral Routing of Signal'

It consists of two parts:

- 1 The CROS with a microphone that picks up sounds and voices presented to the poorer hearing side and wirelessly transmits them to the hearing aid.
- 2 The Audéo Paradise hearing aid that receives the sounds from the poorer hearing side and plays it to your better hearing ear.

Phonak CROS P is based on the proven performance of Phonak Paradise technology. Paradise delivers an unrivaled hearing experience* in even more situations. When CROS P is paired with an Audéo Paradise hearing aid, it enables you to hear sounds around you and follow conversations, regardless of the direction they come from.1**

CROS P utilizes AutoSense OS™ 4.0 — the proprietary operating system from Phonak. AutoSense OS automatically senses your surroundings and adjusts your hearing aid accordingly. It orchestrates various features such as Binaural VoiceStream Technology™, enabling CROS P to wirelessly transfer sounds from the poorer hearing side to the hearing aid on the better hearing ear. This combination of Phonak features allows you to hear your loved ones regardless if they are talking to your poorer hearing side so you can be in the center of the conversation again.

CROS P will keep you aware of sounds when you're walking down the street because it enables you to hear sounds coming from both directions. This means you can be in the center of the conversation without having to consider the best position to stand in. CROS P enables you to hear voices wherever they are coming from.

Get the most out of your Phonak CROS P

Whether you're getting a CROS for the very first time or upgrading from a previous CROS system, here are our top tips.

1 Talk to your hearing care professional (HCP)
Your HCP will ensure that your settings are comfortable. If there are any situations where you feel the sound was not quite right — make a note and go back to your HCP to get CROS P set up in a way that best fits you.

Give it time

Adjusting to anything new takes time; whether it's a new pair of shoes or a new car. Adjusting to CROS P is no different. Everything will sound different at the beginning so be patient with yourself.

Try different environments

Try out familiar situations and then start trying out new environments. Is there somewhere you've avoided because of your hearing loss? See how CROS P makes a difference to your comfort level and enjoyment.

- 4 Tell your friends and family
 Let people know that you're adjusting to new hearing aids and it may take some time to get used to.
- (5) Give yourself a break

 If you've had unilateral hearing loss for a long time, it may take your brain some time to adjust. That is normal. Give yourself a break when needed but remember that the more you use your new CROS P, the better it will be.
